Establishment

It launched its first session on April 01, 2019 with whooping initial strength of about 280 students. It gained the Recognition from the State Education Department under the **Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 on April 12, 2019.**

Formation of School Management Committee

The first step in the proper functioning of the school was the constitution of a School Management Committee with the members out teachers, society members, parents and eminent educationists with a good number of women. It was strictly done under the guidelines of Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009. Some of the important decisions made by SMC are:

• The school has to proceed for CBSE India affiliation. To obtain the NOC from the state education department would be the first step.

- Extensive and rigorous practice for sports should be there.
- Regular field trips and excursions/adventure camps will be organized.
- The school van will have lady attendants.
- Annual budget for Library and Laboratories has been set up.
- A fee regulatory committee has also been set up in terms of PTA.

Clubs

Enhancement of co-curricular activities is being ensured through the process of Clubs. The main student clubs working in the school are – Eco Club, Sports Club, Literary Club, Science Club and Art Club.

Houses

The senior school students have been divided into four House - Broncos House, Raiders House Spartan House and Panthers House. The inter-house activities and competitions inculcate and develop a good and healthy sense of competition amongst the students.

Curriculum

The curriculum of Oxford International School, Hoshiarpur has been designed by Oxford University Press (India) which has been weaved around the NCERT syllabus and CBSE curriculum. It incubates the global measures of learning well into the indigenous and traditional methods, thus, preparing the Global Leaders for Tomorrow.

Faculty Development Programs

The teaching faculty of Oxford International School is as qualified and experienced as expected. The regular training and orientation sessions are held by the Oxford University Press for teachers professional development and refreshment and to enhance the technology usage competency for the teaching learning to be more effective and long lasting.

Safety at workplace for the staff

The safe and professional work environment has been created in the school with the set up of Committee for Protection of Women Again Sexual Harassment under the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 guidelines.

Safety of Children

Safety of students is the top priority for our school. The kindergarten classes, all the washrooms and all the school vans are provided with the full-time female attendants. Corporal punishments and unnecessary mental harassment are completely prohibited in the school. In addition to this to safeguard the interests of the learners, Oxford International School, Jian has set up the POCSO Committee (set up under the provisions of the Prevention of Children from Sexual Offence Act 2012) today on 20 February, 2020. The Committee works towards safeguarding the learners from the challenges they face in their formative years at school. The Committee takes up age-appropriate initiatives to create awareness about sexual exploitation and to ensure that all learners are aware of their rights and responsibilities towards themselves. Training sessions are conducted for the faculty and staff to recognize and report issues of abuse and neglect. Complaint Boxes are placed strategically and checked regularly by the Committee members to address the complaints if any. GPS trackers have also been installed in school buses. And the Safe Vahan Committee has also been constituted.

Fee Regulation Committee -cum- Parents Teachers Association

The school has set up a Fee Regulatory Committee-Cum-Parent Teachers Association. This committee constitutes one parent from each class, one teacher from each wing, one SMC member, Principal and Coordinator of the school. This holds regular meetings and discusses the main root issues w.r.t. the students and studies. This also sets up a proposal for the fee structure for the coming session and puts it before the SMC and DFRC. The main activities of the PTA for this year include – regular monthly PTMs, organization of events like Adventure Camp, Athletic Meet etc. It has decided to take necessary steps to recover fee from long term fee defaulters. It also has decided to implement the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) Education in the school in its full swing and for all classes now.

Contribution for Environment Conservation

The steps being taken for the Environment Conservation are: Formation and functioning of Eco Club, Rain Water Harvesting Plant, Compost Pits, Tree Plantation, prohibition of the use of single use plastic etc. Apart from this Environmental Education is an integral part of our curriculum.

Overall Results

The Results of our last session are 100%. We hope to keep up the same pace.

Important SMC and PTA Decisions of the Year

Some decisions of the School Management Committee and Parent Teachers Association that brought significant development in the school system are as follows:

- 1. A scholarship scheme has been announced for sports achievements.
- 2. Annual Pedagogical Plan should be prepared by the Principal as per CBSE guidelines.
- 3. The school buses should be installed with GPS trackers.
- 4. The school should apply for the upgradation of the Affiliation Level of the school.
- 5. The laboratories should be developed for Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- 6. New classrooms should also be developed as per the need of a Senior Secondary School.
- 7. The teachers should go for regular training modules through CBSE and other institutions.
- 8. The school should also start appointing PGTs.
- 9. Safe Vahan Committee should be constituted as per Govt. guidelines.
